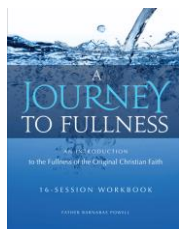

The next **South Group** meeting is TBD. It will continue to take place at the Strickland family's home. The address is: **122 Northaven Street, Farmington, AR 72730.**

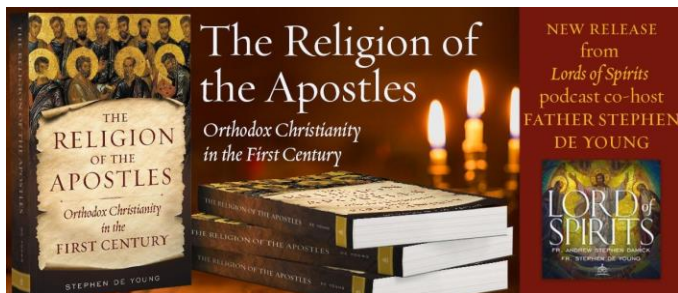

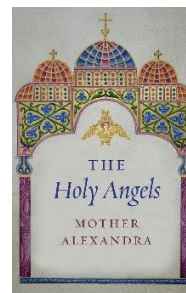
Bookstore Updates
