NO FASTING During the Paschal Season

There is a general dispensation from fasting on Wednesdays and Fridays during Paschal season until the Feast of the Ascension. Most Orthodox jurisdictions throughout the world observe the Wednesdays and Fridays of the period following Bright Week as days of fasting; however, the Holy Synod of Antioch has directed that the entire 40-day period be completely fast-free, as is the more ancient practice.

Parish Directory & Guidebook – PICTURE DAYS


