Church Etiquette Reminder of the Month - Keeping Focus In Worship

We should be focused and attentive during prayer and worship. The clergy often recite this command liturgically: "Let us attend!" or "Stand upright!" Together, we can work on being less distracted and not distracting others if we keep focus during worship!
