Church Etiquette Reminder of the Month - Making the Sign of the Cross

It is always appropriate to cross oneself (make the sign of the cross over your body) at the mention of the Holy Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Also, it is appropriate to cross oneself at the following instances: when entering and leaving the Church Sanctuary, when passing in front of the altar, when venerating an icon or the Gospel, and of course, at any time of personal piety. However, it is not necessary to cross oneself when the priest is offering the blessing ("Peace be unto all") or censing the congregation. Instead, one should simply bow and receive the blessing.
