

It is important to be vocal during the liturgical services; not talking in private conversations, but participating in the worship through singing. Lend your voice, following the choir or chanters. Sunday bulletin offers the "major" hymns that may vary each week for our usage; hymns, such as: Resurrectional Troparion of the Week, Hymn of the Saint/Feast being celebrated, and Troparion of our Patron - St. Nicholas. Also, we print the Vespers services used throughout the week. We should be actively engaged with our worship and communal prayer, offering our voices in praise to God!
