Church Etiquette Reminder of the Month
- Touching the Priest's Vestment

For some, it is a pious custom to touch the hem of the priest's vestment or phelonion as he passes by in the Great Entrance with the Holy Gifts. This practice imitates the woman who was healed by touching the hem of Christ's robe, as recorded in the Gospels: Matthew 9:18-26, Mark 5:24-34, Luke 8:42-48. When touching the hem of the priest's phelonion, one should be careful not to step in front of the procession or pull on the garment.
