<u>Church Etiquette Reminder of the Month</u> - "Preparing to receive Holy Communion"

On Sundays when we are receiving Holy Communion, we should not eat or drink anything, beginning from when we wake up until after we receive Communion. Exceptions usually include small children and medicine needed for anyone. If it is an Evening Liturgy and you plan to receive Communion, you should begin the "Eucharistic" fast (no food or drink) after a noon meal lunch. Also, we should have had a "recent" Confession, and have peace of heart and mind with others. It is also a pious custom to recite the Pre-Communion Prayers and Post-Communion Prayers. These are spiritual disciplines that we "get" to participate in and adjusted accordingly in consultation with the parish priest.
