OCLife Ministry - March 2024

During the month of March, our church, through our affiliation with Orthodox Christians for Life, will be joining with Orthodox parishes across the country in holding a "baby shower" to support mothers who choose life for their unborn children! This donation drive will benefit Compassion House, a local residential facility for teen mothers, and Loving Choices, a pregnancy resource center. Donation requests are:

Loving Choices: baby board books, pacifiers, baby bottles, new or gently used maternity clothes, crib sheets. They do have needs for larger items like high chairs, baby swings, or pack and plays if several want to join as a group to donate an item like that.

Compassion House: newborn clothes (both genders) and diapers.

Also inviting any who would like to participate in providing a dinner for the residents at Compassion House during the month of March, the open dates are March 4, 11, 18, 21, 25, 28. Perhaps two or three could get together to provide the meal for a total of 9 including residents and staff. They request meals be dropped between 5 and 6 PM.

Pre-Sanctified Liturgy & Lenten Potluck - Wednesdays during Great Lent

We will rotate hosting on Wednesday evenings during Great Lent with our sister parish of St. John of Chicago Orthodox Church in Rogers (1740 9th St.). ONLY the host parish needs to provide lenten food and drinks for the Potluck. We will host on Wednesdays: March 20, April 3, & April 17.

Church Etiquette Reminder of the Month - "Eucharistic Fast"

It is proper to refrain (fast) from food and drink prior to receiving Holy Communion. If it is a morning Liturgy (such as on Sunday), we begin our fast from when we go to bed. If it is an evening Liturgy (such as Pre-Sanctified Liturgy during Great Lent), we should begin a fast after a light noon meal.
