## Pascha & Bright Week Reminders & Announcements

It is the celebratory custom for households to bring their own Paschal baskets for Fellowship after the Paschal services late Saturday night. This gathering is NOT a Potluck, but we will have deli trays provided by the Church. The fellowship on Sunday, April 20 after Agape Vespers will be a Potluck of side items ONLY. The entrees are being provided by the Church.



It is a pious practice to offer an additional donation during the Paschal season for the needs of the parish community. Please mark "paschal offering" on the envelope. Many thanks!

Join us at 1:00p for Agape Vespers followed by Fellowship. The church is providing the entrees, but we ask parishioners to bring side dishes and desserts for our meal. **Our children will participate in an Egg Hunt and craft!** 

- \*\*Confessions will NOT be heard during Holy Week & Bright Week.
- \*\*We leave open the Beautiful Gate and the Deacons' Doors for all of Bright Week until Great Vespers on Saturday.
- \*\*There will be no fasting on Wednesdays and Fridays, not only during Bright Week but until the Feast of the Ascension, for the whole forty days. (*This was the decision of the Holy Synod of the Patriarchate of Antioch in 1997*).
- \*\*During Bright Week (this week), we read the Paschal Office in place of Morning and Evening Prayers at our homes, as well as in place of Compline, Midnight Office, the Hours, and the Prayers of Thanksgiving after Holy Communion. It is also read on the leave-taking of Pascha. Printed copies available in the Narthex.
